**The main goal** of the scientific and communication event is to consolidate the professional community of cultural, scientific, educational institutions of Ukraine and the world to discuss priority areas of work and highlight successful practices in the study, preservation, protection, and popularization of cultural and historical heritage; to exchange the experience of national and international experts in book studies, library and bibliography, archives, museum studies, information activities; highlight the issues of digital representation of documentary monuments as an important aspect of the activities of cultural and memory institutions.

**Thematic areas of the conference:**

- libraries, archives, museums as institutions of preservation of national memory: history and development;
- collections of documentary monuments in the funds of cultural and memory institutions: history of formation and current state;
- historical and cultural monuments as objects of local history activities;
- national book studies, library studies, archival studies, museum studies: research directions and achievements;
- outstanding personalities of Ukrainian book studies, library studies, archival studies and museum studies - their life path and professional achievements;
- national book printing: origin and development (to the 450th anniversary of the printing house founded in Lviv by Ivan Fedorov);
- preservation of documentary monuments in the face of threats of military conflicts: storage, conservation, and restoration technologies;
- international and national digital projects as a tool for preserving, accessing, and promoting historical and cultural heritage: experience and innovations.

The conference will be held at Odesa National Scientific Library in a mixed format (online/offline). Working languages: Ukrainian, English.

Participation in the conference is free of charge, *pre-registration is required* ([via the link](#)) - **until November 20, 2023**.

After the event, participants will receive an electronic certificate.

### **Requirements for abstracts:**

- manuscripts in Ukrainian or English are accepted for publication;
- the text should be typed in MS Word;
- for abstracts in English, an abstract in Ukrainian (100-150 words), which summarizes the content of the article, is required at the beginning of the article;

- the volume of abstracts is 2-6 full pages of A4 format;
- font - Times New Roman;
- size - 14;
- line spacing - 1.5;
- paragraph indentation - 1.25 cm;
- margins: top, bottom, left and right - 20 mm;
- alignment - by width;
- pages are not numbered;
- Figures, tables or graphs should be placed immediately after the text where they are mentioned for the first time or on the next page;
- in the text, references to the used sources are given in square brackets: the number of the cited source in the list of references is indicated first, then the page number, for example: [1, p. 25]. The list of references should be drawn up in accordance with State Standards of Ukraine 8302:2015 and given at the end of the article in alphabetical order, in the original language;
- the UDC index should be indicated before the title of the report (alignment on the left edge, bold); then - the name of the conference participant, academic degree and position, place of work (full name); city, country; title of the report (in capital letters, bold, centered alignment).

Abstracts that do not comply with the requirements will not be accepted.
